Terms of Laterality

- - ***Bilateral***: Structures or organs that occur on both sides (right and left) of the body.
- - ***Unilateral***: A structure or organ occurring only on one side of the body.
- - ***Ipsilateral***: A structure occurring on the same side of the body as another structure.
- - ***Contralateral***: A structure occurring on the opposite side of the body with reference to another structure.

Examples

- - Bilateral: e.g., the hands
- - Unilateral: e.g., the stomach, spleen.
- - Ipsilateral: e.g., the right hand and right foot
- - Contralateral: e.g., the right foot is contralateral to the left foot
